**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY MOTION TO INTERVENE TO
ASSERT RIGHTS UNDER THE CRIME VICTIMS' RIGHTS ACT.**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court on the Emergency Motion to Intervene to Assert Rights Under the Crime Victims' Rights Act, (the "Motion"), and this Court having considered the motion, the statements of the alleged victims, other related documents and pleadings, and heard argument, if allowed, hereby

FINDS, that Fotini Tsavousis Duncombe, Theodore Thoma, and Eric Forrer have submitted statements showing that they have been harmed by the illegal action of the Defendant and should have a right to participate in the proposed joint resolution proceedings pursuant to the Crime Victims' Rights Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3771 and, additionally or alternatively, under 18 U.S.C. § 3661; and it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

The Motion is GRANTED. Fotini Tsavousis Duncombe, Theodore Thoma, and Eric Forrer ("Victims") are hereby afforded rights under the Crime Victims' Rights Act, and should also be heard under 18 U.S.C. § 3661.

This Court shall defer consideration of the proposed joint resolution until (1) Victims are provided access to the evidence of Carnival's ongoing criminal activities, as found by the Government; (2) Victims are provided access to the proposed joint resolution; (3) then, with that knowledge, Victims are provided an opportunity to confer with the attorneys for the government; and (4) Victims are provided an opportunity to submit written and oral testimony on the proposed joint resolution to this Court.
